Despite the challenges faced by a global pandemic, UHRI facilitated 78 virtual and in-person intergroup dialogues with schools and universities, medical professionals, businesses, and local community organizations.

35k+ visits to UDHR videos and recordings

By the end of 2021 we have contributed to organizing, updating and adding to the United Nations' Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) resulting in 560 total translations and 131 recordings of the UDHR. Our multi-lingual UDHR <u>videos</u> and <u>recordings</u> received over 35k views and visitors from from 176 countries.

Top language videos viewed were: Polish, Hindi, Bengali, Tamil, Hungarian, Tagalog, Urdu, Portuguese, Spanish and Turkish. Top viewing countries were: Philippines, United States, China, Brazil, India, Poland, Bulgaria, Hungary and Romania. Forthcoming translations include: Alsatian, Maltese and Palestinian Arabic.
